

Prisma Health—MidlandsSM is an affiliate of Prisma HealthSM, the largest not-for-profit health organization in South Carolina, serving more than 1.2 million patients annually. Prisma Health's 30,000 team members are dedicated to supporting the health and well-being of patients and families.

Prisma Health—Midlands is the largest and most comprehensive integrated health care system in the Midlands of South Carolina. There are nearly 15,000 team members, physicians and volunteers.

Philanthropic support of Prisma Health—Midlands through Prisma Health Midlands Foundation is significant because of the high cost of health care.

In FY 2018, **67.51 percent** of Prisma Health's total billings was for patients without private insurance. Only **15.45 percent** of these charges was collected.

**Emergency
Medicine/
Trauma**

When people don't have insurance, they tend to delay seeking health care until a crisis drives them to the Emergency Department. Accidents happen. Sometimes, those accidents require Trauma services. Prisma Health Richland operates a Level I Trauma Center—the only one of its kind in the Midlands.

In FY 2018, Trauma charges alone were \$150 million but only \$31.1 million in revenue was collected.

**Children's
Hospital**

Each year, Prisma Health Children's Hospital—Midlands sees more than 150,000 patient visitors through its inpatient and outpatient facilities. Many complex illnesses and injuries demand highly specialized care, yet many children's health care services are not reimbursed.

The Midlands has the highest percentage of Medicaid pediatric patients in South Carolina. About 61 percent of children cared for at Prisma Health Children's Hospital—Midlands are Medicaid patients. The Midlands has the least supportive private payer mix in the state. Two out of three Children's Hospital patients have health coverage through a government provider. These reimbursements do not cover the full cost of the care provided.
