*You can be proud of how Atrium Society funds have been used in the last 10 years.*

- 2009-2011** \$101,119 raised in support of upgrades for the latest digital mammography equipment
- 2012-2013** \$70,770 raised to provide sofa beds for patient rooms at Prisma Health Baptist Hospital
- 2014** Nearly \$50,000 to support purchase of an automated whole breast ultrasound unit at Prisma Health Breast Center
- 2015** \$60,000 raised + \$62,000 gift from the late John and Betty Warren to fund a new 3D mammography unit for Prisma Health Breast Center
- 2016** Nearly \$50,000 raised to fund a two-day oncology nurse review program and expand the cancer genetic counseling program at Prisma Health Cancer Centers
- 2017** \$81,000 to help the Foundation fully fund a microwave ablation system used to destroy cancerous lesions
- 2018** \$100,000 to help the Foundation fully fund a radio frequency ablation unit that will help prevent esophageal cancer
- 2019** \$110,000 to fund two new advancements - a breast cancer localization system (\$58,000) that helps surgeons pinpoint breast cancer tumors during surgery and bronchoscopy equipment (estimated at \$52,400) to treat lung cancer patients with windpipe tumors.
